Wound Care following **Toe Nail Surgery**

- 1. Wash nail bed with Surgical Scrub twice daily
- 2. Dip cotton tipped applicators into the surgical soap & rub into the wound removing any scab or drainage
- 3. Rinse well and Pat Dry
- 4. Rub in Neosporin or Triple Antibiotic Ointment
- 5. Cover with 1 gauze sponge & Coflex wrap for about a week
- 6. After about a week, leave open to the air. If there is some drainage, you may cover the toe when wearing shoes & socks
- 7. Wear a comfortable shoe for the first 5-7 days
